Characteristics of Jazz. What separates Jazz from the vast majority of classical pieces is rhythm and use of rhythm. A key distinguishing feature is a rhythmic device called 'swing'. Swing rhythm calls for performers to change the values of quaver or eighth-notes from equal to a ratio closely resembling two-thirds to one-third.
